Family Hall New Menu

A new a la carte menu is being introduced in the Club from July 15, 2009. Besides improvements in the traditional popular dishes of Islamabad Club, the menu features new varieties of appetizers, Chinese, Continental and local cuisine. Electronic Membership Cards (E-Cards)

Islamabad Club has started issuing e-cards to its members and their families (spouse & children under the age of 26 years). Members are requested to provide the following for preparation of their e-cards:

1. One photograph of each family member (passport size, blue background). Please mention name and membership number on the back of each photograph.
2. Copies of CNIC (for eighteen years & above) / 'B' Form (for below eighteen years).
3. After the photographs & documents have been provided, cards may be collected after two working days. Members are requested to collect the cards themselves.

Amendment in Club Rules/ Bye-laws

The Managing Committee; in its meeting of June 18, 2009; has approved the following changes in the relevant Club rules:

Rule # 3 (5): Members, sub heading 'Families of Members' clause # 5 will read as follows: Family members of an elected member will automatically become "Family" members of the club and be allowed to use the club facilities. The term "Family" will include the spouse, unmarried daughters and sons up to the age of 26 years provided they are non-earning. Unmarried/divorced/separated daughters above the age of twenty six can retain their family cards with an additional monthly subscription. Unmarried sons/daughters upto the age of 26 years except where the son/daughter is financially dependent on the member and is medically incapacitated or under some permanent disability, Managing Committee may extend his/her term for a specified period. However, an additional monthly subscription will be charged in all such cases. In case of family members the onus of dress, decorum and general conduct of the family will be the personal responsibility of the member.

Bye-Law # 3 Member's Family, sub heading 'Family' clause # 1 (b) will read as follows: Unmarried/divorced/separated daughters above the age of twenty six can retain their family cards with an additional monthly subscription. Unmarried sons/daughters upto the age of 26 years except where the son/daughter is financially dependent on the member and is medically incapacitated or under some permanent disability, Managing Committee may extend his/her term for a specified period. However, an additional monthly subscription will be charged in all such cases.

Observance of Club Rules & Bye-Laws

Members are requested to adhere strictly to the following club bye-laws:

Bye-Law # 5 (2): Entertaining of Guests: "Only those gentlemen/ladies may be introduced into the Club who are in their own right eligible for membership".

Bye-Law # 10 (3): Private servants not allowed in the Club: "Private servants are not allowed in any part of the club. The drivers, body guards and maid servants etc are not allowed beyond the car park".

2. Members are requested not to leave their cars parked while they are not present in the club.
3. Chauffeur driven & Squad Cars should use Car Park # 2 & 3. Car Park # 1 should be used for Member's driven cars only.
